
G.H. Hardy, LMS President (1926 - 1928 and 1939 - 1941)

As well as being the 150th Anniversary of the Society, 2015 also saw the 150th Anniversary of the Proceedings of the London Mathematical Society including the first paper published and the speech given by Augustus de Morgan at the first Society meeting. The Proceedings has published many famous papers in its 150 years including particular papers by Hardy (left) and Ramanujan, Turing, Marstrand, Atiyah, and Donaldson, to name but a very few, each of them a landmark in their field. During 2015 Oxford University Press kindly agreed to make freely available several famous papers published by the Society. These were publicised via Twitter and made available on the LMS website.

The Journals Tender Group, assigned with choosing a new publishing partner for the Society from 2017, considered nine bids received from publishers and three were interviewed in February. The LMS Council has subsequently accepted the Group's recommendation that Wiley should be the Society's next publisher. The detailed contract with Wiley was agreed in November 2015.

Starting in 2015, LMS individual members were offered free online access to Nonlinearity, published jointly the LMS and the Institute of Physics. This supplements the offer, introduced in 2014, of free online access to the Bulletin, Journal and Proceedings of the LMS.

The LMS has publicised a Guide to Authors which gives an overview of the peer review process as it applies to the Bulletin, Journal, Proceedings and Transactions of the LMS. This is available on the LMS website: www.lms.ac.uk/sites/lms.ac.uk/files/Publications/AuthorGuide.pdf



The number of printed pages has decreased in 2015 by 14% for the Bulletin, by 17% for the Journal, 9% for the Proceedings, and 8% for the Journal of Topology. For Compositio Mathematica, there has been an increase of 9%.

Mathematika, published by the LMS on behalf of University College London, moved from two issues to three issues per year from 2015 and the number of printed pages was increased by 47%.

The open access online journal Transactions of the London Mathematical Society has published eight papers since its launch in 2014. Papers submitted before January 2016 will continue to benefit from a reduced open access charge (APC): www.lms.ac.uk/publications/tlms-submit#APC. From January 2016, charges will be tiered; see the back page for details.

This edition of the London Mathematical Society's Publications Catalogue lists:


- journals published by the Society itself;

LMS BOOK SERIES

The London Mathematical Society aims to disseminate mathematical knowledge as widely as possible in the interests of its members and the international mathematical community. To this end, it sponsors two book series: the LMS Lecture Notes and the LMS Student Texts. The Society appoints Academic Editors and Advisers for each series to take responsibility for ensuring high academic quality. It uses the expertise of two professional publishing houses (Cambridge University Press and the American Mathematical Society) to produce, advertise and distribute its books. The Series Publishers and Editors offer advice to authors throughout the process from writing to publication and distribution. The books are marketed and sold by the publishing houses, and they are also advertised through the Society's annual Publications Catalogue and the monthly Newsletter of the LMS. Members can purchase volumes at substantial discounts.

In general, a proposal should consist of an explanation of why the book is being written and for whom, some sample material – preferably a chapter or more and a table of contents – and a brief description of the background and expertise that you can bring. An estimate of the length of the book and a practical time schedule for completion of the manuscript may also be requested by the Editors. Initial enquiries, proposals or manuscripts should be sent to the most appropriate series Editor. Each series also has an Advisory Board, and you may wish to recommend a member of the board as an expert in your field. The Advisory Boards are small, but this does not reflect the breadth of a series. The Editor and the publishing house will find a suitable reviewer for well-prepared proposals.

The Editor of each series will be delighted to give you further information and advice about that series; alternatively you may contact the Publisher, Dr Susan Hezlet (susan.hezlet@lms.ac.uk), for general guidance on which series may be the most suitable home for your book.


